
About the Center on Rural Innovation

The <u>Center on Rural Innovation</u> (CORI) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit capacity-building organization that partners with rural communities in their own efforts to develop tech economies.

Established in 2017, CORI is at the heart of a dynamic social enterprise focused on closing the rural economic opportunity gap. To maximize all possible resources to address this critical problem, CORI collaborates with a taxable nonprofit, Rural Innovation Strategies, Inc. (RISI), and a seed fund, the CORI Innovation Fund, focused on early-stage technology companies located in rural areas.

About the Rural Innovation Network

CORI's <u>Rural Innovation Network</u> is a nationwide community of change agents and local leaders working to advance the economic futures of their rural communities. The 38 member communities receive ongoing support, guidance, and mentorship from CORI's team. Members also have access to CORI's economic expertise, data and mapping tools, accelerated programming, working groups, and national resources and partnerships to draw from as they advance their tech economy ecosystem strategies.

About Red Wing, Minnesota

This year's Rural Innovation Network Summit and CORI Conference will be held in Red Wing, Minnesota, a city of nearly 17,000 that is located about an hour southeast from the Twin Cities.

A Network member since 2019, <u>Red Wing Ignite</u> has spearheaded the region's tech-based economic development work, connecting key sectors of the community to share ideas, resources, and expertise that spur innovation. Since opening in 2013, Red Wing Ignite has served more than 340 entrepreneurs and secured more than \$5 million in EDA grant funding to support its efforts. Its annual pitch competition, the E1 Ignite Cup, has showcased exciting startups for nearly a decade and served as a springboard to state- and national-level competitions.

CORI is excited that attendees of this year's Summit and Conference will have a chance to explore and learn everything Red Wing has to offer as a model for supporting rural innovation.
